Nico Grilli (SR-Cherokee)- Runner of the Year: Grilli won the Burlington County Open, was runner-up at the Olympic Conference American Division Championship, and placed 3rd at the South Jersey Group 4 Sectional Championship. He broke 17 minutes every time out, and he had a season best of 16:07 at the Olympic Conference race.

Alex Boyko (SO-Cinnaminson): One of three sophomores on the team, Boyko finished 6th at the Burlington County Open, and led Cinnaminson to a Central Group 2 Sectional title, placing 8th.

Jake Buniva (JR-Lenape): Buniva placed 9th at the Burlington County Open, and ran a season's best 16:38 at the Olympic Conference American Division race, placing 11th.

Patrick Ditmars (SO-Cherokee): Ditmars finished 12th at the Burlington County Open, and 11th at the South Group 4 Sectional Championships.

Andre Faigal (JR-Rancocas Valley): Faigal was 4th at the Burlington County Open, and 17th at the South Group 4 Sectional Championship. He ran a season's best 16:45.

Connor Jacob (SO-Cherokee): Jacob placed 13th at the Burlington County Open, and had a season's best 16:33 at the Olympic Conference Championship.

Paul Kresloff (SO-Moorestown): Kresloff finished 5th at the Burlington County Open, and led Moorestown to an undefeated batch meet season.

Dylan Odud (SR-Cherokee): Odud placed 7th at the Burlington County Open, and 12th at the South Group 4 Sectional Championships.

John Ruona (SR-Shawnee): Rouna was 3rd at the Burlington County Open, and 4th at the Olympic Conference Championship where he ran a season's best 16:14.

Brett Shea (SR-Cherokee): Shea was the County Open runner-up, 6th at the Olympic Conference Championship, and South Group 4 Sectional Championship. He broke 17 minutes 5x this season, running a personal best of 16:24 at the Olympic Conference race.
